<u>Visiting Hours</u>	Wednesdays 6:30p to 7:30p

All visitors must attend the Educational Seminar before visiting the patient

- **All visitors must have consent in chart signed by the patient and approved by the primary counselor.**
- **Visitors must sign in and out at the front desk, place belongings in locker, obtain an ID tag, before arrival to the Partial Building for the seminar.**
- **Visitors must sign in next to their name on the Master List in the Partial Building and give all items brought in for patients to the staff.**
- **Bags will be inspected upon completion of seminar and visit. Therefore, patient's name must be on the items.**
- **Two visitors will be permitted to visit at one time.**
- **Late arrivals will not be permitted to visit with patients.**

Family Educational Seminar Includes:

- **Explanation of Facility's Program**
- **Drug and Alcohol Education**
- **Co-occurring Diagnoses**
- **The importance of a Positive Support System, Medication Compliance/Management, Intensive Outpatient Therapy, 12-Step Fellowships**
- **Opportunity for family/friends to ask program questions**

Other Visiting Expectations

- **No physical contact is permitted between visitors and patients with the exception of a hello/goodbye kiss/hug.**
- **Violence of any sort will not be tolerated.**
- **Anyone under age 16 years of age will not be permitted to visit.**
- **Visitors must be respectful to staff/patients at all times or will be asked to leave the grounds.**
- **Visitors can bring make-up, hard candy, books, and minimal amounts of money.**
- **Visitors cannot bring glass items, lighters/matches, pillows, blankets, stuffed animals, alcohol based products, DVD's, CD's, Laptop Computers, etc.**
